4 G-FORCE

- Actually, G-force is a term used in physics.
- It is a measurement of the strength of gravity placed on an object.
- Basically, it's how many multiples of (G) we feel.
 - In space we experience zero Gs.
 - Sitting still in your chair you experience 1-G.
 - Riding a Roller Coaster you may experience up to 3 or 4-Gs.
 - Flying in a High Performance Jet Fighter you may experience up to 7 or even 10-Gs.

5 G-FORCE

- Actually, G-force is a term used in physics.
- It is a measurement of the strength of gravity placed on an object.
- Basically, it's how many multiples of (G) we feel.
 - Sitting still in your chair you experience 1-G.
 - Riding a Roller Coaster you may experience up to 4-Gs.

6 G-Force

- There is another force in the Universe.
 - It too is invisible.
 - Has a profound affect on everyone and everything.
 - It worked greatly in the life of Jesus of Nazareth. [God gave to Him] . . . Spirit without limit. (John 3:34 NIV)
- As John the Baptist testified, I saw the Spirit come down from heaven as a dove and remain on him. (John 1:32 NIV)
- Jesus had G-Force "God-Force" or "Spirit-Force" in his life.

7 G-Force

- Why do we know Jesus had G-Force in His life?

- Men of Israel, listen to this: Jesus of Nazareth was a man accredited by God to you by miracles, wonders and signs, which God did among you through him, as you yourselves know. (Acts 2:22 NIV)
- Jesus replied, “Go back and report to John what you hear and see: The blind receive sight, the lame walk, those who have leprosy are cured, the deaf hear, the dead are raised, and the good news is preached to the poor.” (Matthew 11:4–5 NIV)
- Believe . . . on the evidence of the miracles themselves. (John 14:11 NIV)

8 Jesus Disciples Had G–Force

- Jesus gives G–Force to His Disciples
 - Calling the Twelve to him, he sent them out two by two and gave them authority over evil spirits . . . They went out and preached that people should repent. They drove out many demons and anointed many sick people with oil and healed them. (Mark 6:6–13 NIV)
 - But I tell you the truth: It is for your good that I am going away. Unless I go away, the Counselor will not come to you; but if I go, I will send him to you.(John 16:7–8 NIV)

9 Jesus Disciples Had G–Force

- Jesus gives G–Force to His Disciples
 - On one occasion, while he was eating with them, he gave them this command: “Do not leave Jerusalem, but wait for the gift my Father promised, which you have heard me speak about. 5 For John baptized with water, but in a few days you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit.” (Acts 1:4–5 NIV)
 - When the day of Pentecost came, they were all together in one place. Suddenly a sound like the blowing of a violent wind came from heaven and filled the whole house where they were sitting. . . . All of them were filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other tongues as the Spirit enabled them. (Acts 2:1–4 NIV)

10 The Early Church Had G–Force

- When Peter saw this, he said to them: “Men of Israel, why does this surprise you? Why do you stare at us as if by our own power . . . we had made this man walk? . . . 15 You killed the author of life, but God raised him from the dead. We are witnesses of this. 16 By faith in the name of Jesus, this man whom you see and know was made strong. It is Jesus’ name and the faith that comes through him that has given this complete healing to him, as you can all see. (Acts 3:12–16 NIV)

11 Early Church Had G–Force

- Effect of G–Force on the Early Church
 - Everyone was filled with awe, and many wonders and miraculous signs were done by the apostles. All the believers were together and had everything in common. Selling their possessions and goods, they gave to anyone as he had need. (Acts 2:43–45 NIV)

- What did G-Force produced in the early church?
 - Signs, wonders, and miracles
 - Harmony
 - Generosity and Charity (love)

12 G-FORCE

- The Apostle Paul's Prayer (Eph. 1:18-21):
 - God would give us the Spirit of Wisdom and Revelation.
 - Know the following:
 - Know God!
 - The great inheritance we have waiting for us in heaven.
 - The incomparably great power for those who believe.
 - Working of God's mighty strength
 - Same power God used to raise Jesus from the dead.
 - Same power God used to exalt Jesus above all authorities.

13 G-FORCE

- Paul Prayer in Ephesians 3:16-21
 - I pray that out of his glorious riches he may strengthen you with power through his Spirit in your inner being, 17 so that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith.
 - And I pray that you, being rooted and established in love, 18 may have power, together with all the saints, to grasp how wide and long and high and deep is the love of Christ, 19 and to know this love that surpasses knowledge — that you may be filled to the measure of all the fullness of God. (Ephesians 3:14-19 NIV)
 - Now to him who is able to do immeasurably more than all we ask or imagine, according to his power that is at work within us, 21 to him be glory in the church and in Christ Jesus throughout all generations, for ever and ever! (Ephesians 3:20-21)

14 Hinderances to G-Force

- The Apostle James tells us (James 1:2-8) that a double-minded man should not expect anything from God. Instead we should believe and not doubt.
- Jesus tells us (Luke 8:14-15) that when we allow life's worries, and the pursuit of riches and pleasure to occupy our lives we become unfruitful.
- Jesus also tells us (Matthew 7:26) that when we listen to God's word but do not put it into practice bring about great sorrow and misfortune.

15 Divine Power

- His divine power has given us everything we need for life and godliness through our knowledge of him who called us by his own glory and goodness. 4 Through these he has given us his very great and precious promises, so that through them you may participate in the divine nature and escape the corruption in the world caused by evil desires. (2 Peter 1:3–4 NIV)
- Put into action what you believe and it will be manifested.
- Use our faith and see what happens.
