Celebration Service – Pastor David McCowan (The Liquid Armor of God)

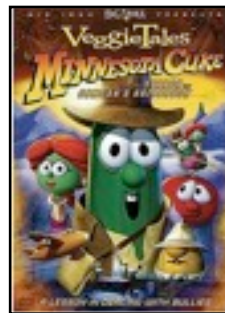
