Celebration Service - Pastor McCowan "Bad Moon Rising"

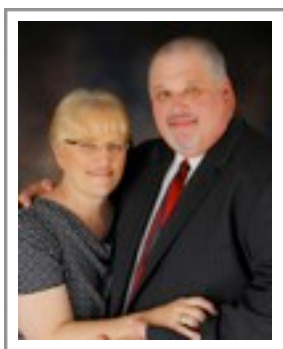
