- fervent having or showing great emotion or zeal. Extremely hot; glowing. It derives from a word meaning "to boil."
- zeal tireless devotion for a person, cause, or ideal-determination in its furtherance, diligent enthusiasm, powerful interest.
- maintain cause or enable (a condition or state of affairs) to continue, conserve, keep, retain, preserve, sustain.

 - Forsaking the assembly of God's people. (Just because you have an excuse doesn't mean you have to take it. It is OK to make the devil mad.)
 - Not serving in some capacity at my local church with the motive of doing it unto the Lord.

- We are to be fervent in love. Above all, keep fervent in your love for one another. 1 Peter 4:8a
- We are to be fervent in prayer. Epaphras, who is one of you, a servant of Christ Jesus, greets you, always struggling on your behalf in his prayers, that you may stand mature and fully assured in all the will of God. Col. 4:12
- We are to be fervent or zealous in good deeds. Christ gave Himself for us to redeem us from every lawless deed, and to purify for Himself a people for His own possession, zealous for good deeds. Titus 2:14
