Just recently, OpenDoors Ministry has released their World Watch List for 2014. The (WWL) is a ranking of 50 countries where persecution of Christians for religious reason is the most severe. While North Korea once again tops the list, 18 of the top 20 countries are Islamic. While religious intolerance is never good, Jesus tells us not to be surprised of such things. In fact there is a war going on between light and darkness that affects us all and puts our faith to the test. Tonight, Pastor McCowan will share how we should respond to this reality.
