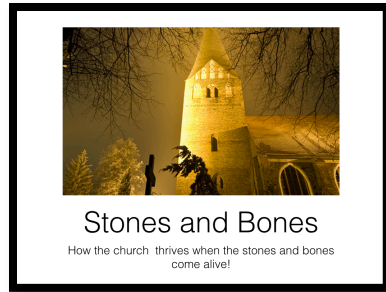
WHAT IS EKKLESIA?

The structural integrity of the Abbey Church of Saint Peter and Saint Paul in Bath, England, is threatened because it sits on too many bones. For over 1,300 years, the basement has been the resting place of some 6,000 parishioners. Now the very foundation of the church is in jeopardy and if something is not done soon the whole church building could crumble. Is there a lesson here?
