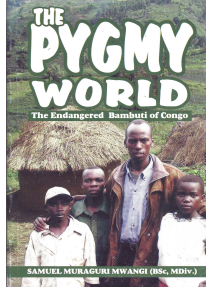
Pastor McCowan will share tonight, "The Lord's Lawn Work"
