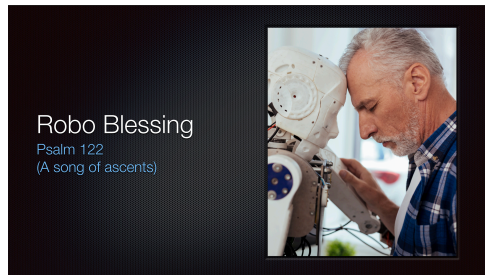
WHAT IS EKKLESIA?
